SALT LAKE CITY, Utah – Five people in need of safe, affordable and accessible housing will be moving into their own apartments thanks to a collaborative effort between Utah Food Bank, Housing Authority of the County of Salt Lake and Utah Division of Services for People with Disabilities.

Utah Food Bank Services recently provided the Housing Authority the opportunity for ownership and management of the Six-Plex located within South Salt Lake. Utilizing funding from the Olene Walker Housing Loan Fund, the property has received upgrades and renovation making it an ideal place to call home for five individuals receiving support services through Utah Division of Services for People with Disabilities.
